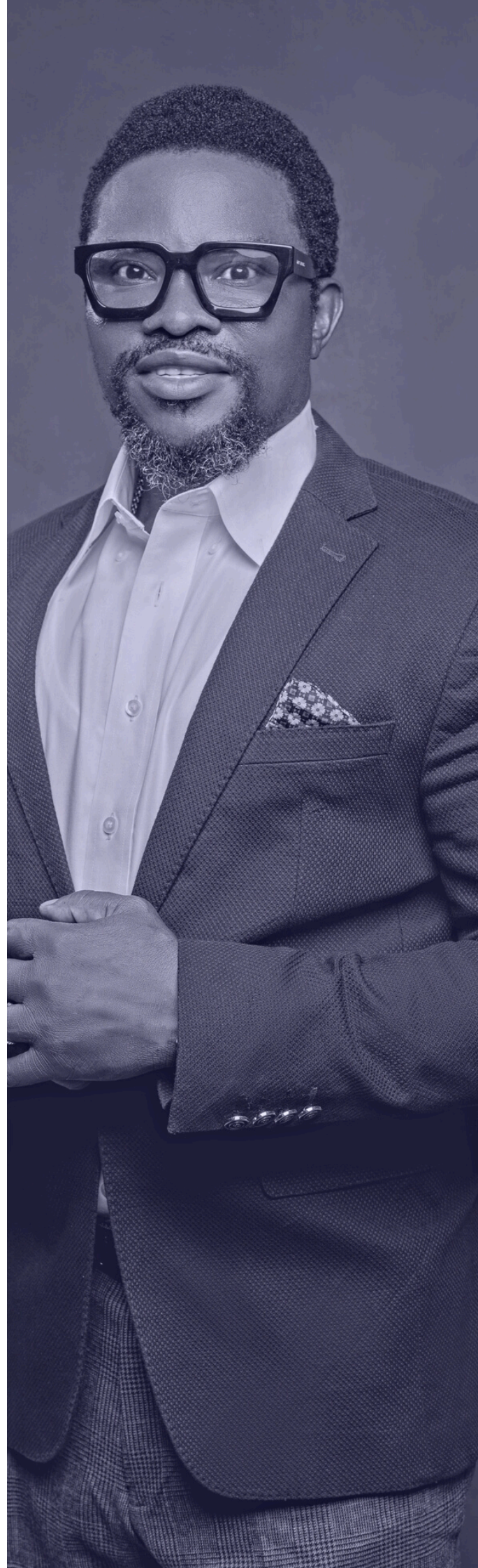

POLITICAL ACTIVITIES



Hon. Ogbe Paul Okechukwu's political career is littered with a roll call of growth and progress, his political adventures began with his selection as part of the Enugu state contingent on entertainment to the people's Democratic Party's Jos Convention in 1998, this was quickly followed by his first appointment as a humble Storekeeper at the Enugu State Government House from 1999 -2000.

His dedication and commitment to service even in this humble role was quickly recognized and rewarded with an appointment as special Aid to the governor in 2000.

During his time as Special Aid, Paul Ogbe invented the Government House Band Unit, which was later attached to the Public Enlightenment unit in 2003. He was then duly elected as an Hon. Councilor for Ward 3 Obeagu Awkunanaw, Enugu South Local Government from 2003 to 2005, later Pual Ogbe became an Hon. Supervisor for Agriculture from 2005 to 2006 in the same Local Government.

His dedication and leadership led to his election as an Hon. Member of the Enugu State House of Assembly, representing Enugu South Urban Constituency, where he served as the Committee Chairman on Youths, Sports and Security Matters, from 2007 to 2015. During this time, he also chaired the Enugu Sub Committee for the World Cup U17 Nigeria 2009 on accreditation, volunteerism, and ICT.

From 2017 to 2019, he was again duly elected as the Deputy Chairman of Enugu South Local Government Council. In the private sector, Paul Ogbe is the CEO of Able Agro Base Resources Ltd. Currently, He is the Senior Special Assistant on Youth Mobilization (east) to His Excellency, Dr, Peter Ndubuisi Mbah, Governor Enugu State.
